BY MAIL

Want to Vote By Mail?

For your convenience, any registered voter may vote by Mail ballot. A voter, member of the voter's immediate family or legal guardian may request an absentee ballot in person, by mail or by telephone. One request can cover all elections through the next two regularly scheduled general elections.

Requests for Mail-in ballots must be made 5 days prior to Election Day for absentee ballots must be in the Supervisor's Office by 7 p.m. on Election Day, in order to count.

Signature Update

Any time there is a change in your signature or identifying "mark", you must complete a new registration application & submit it to the Elections Office. If your signature on your voter record and the match, your absentee ballot will not count.

How To MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT

Our tabulation system uses an optical scanner to read your ballot. You must completely fill in the oval for your vote to count.
